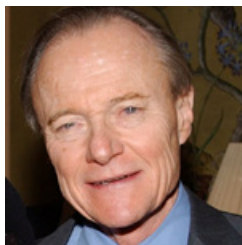
Vintage Hollywood. They also donate to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, Multiple
